

Church lunches are changing!

From then on, lunches will take place on the second Sunday in the month. There will be a prepared cooked meal and dessert served. You won't need to bring anything but donations towards the cost of the food will be gratefully received with any extra going to the church charity (The Smiles Foundation). You will need to sign up the Sunday before, so we know how many to cook for.

Hopefully these new arrangements will suit our needs as a church family better given where we are as a church at the moment. If you're able to volunteer to help prepare and/or serve a lunch periodically please see Ruth or Steve Smith or a member of the leadership team.

Can you help?

I'm wondering if you might be able to put out a call for help across your churches. We have a young mum in our church with a 4 year old who has been given leave to remain, we have helped her find a house in North Ormesby but it is an empty shell - no cooker, fridge or furniture. She has no income as she is waiting for a Universal Credit payment. We have supported her in making a great application for help with furniture, but they will not process this until UC is in place. She has been staying with a friend but now has to

move out, so we are trying to pull together bits and pieces to allow her to move in to her new home until all the money and grants get sorted.

If you can help in anyway with furniture and household goods that would be fantastic! Please could you put out a request across your churches? Ideally, we would like stuff asap. If people can let us know what they might have to offer - just so we don't end up with 10 beds or sofas!!

We are sorting out some gifts of money to tide her over so she has food and fuel, it is really furniture/cooker/fridge/household goods that are needed.
