We have supported her in making a great application for help with furniture, but they will not process this until UC is in place. She has been staying with a friend but now has to move out, so we are trying to pull together bits and pieces to allow her to move in to her new home until all the money and grants get sorted.

We are sorting out some gifts of money to tide her over so she has food and fuel.
