Ensure that full information is supplied eg. date, time, location, cost and the key information about the event, N.B. remember the website and Facebook are public facing media so avoid 'churchy' jargon and use terminology that members of the public will understand,

Write the notice as you want it to appear so it does not need to be re-written. If in doubt about how it should appear please mention this in your email

Include any image you want to appear with your notice ensuring that it is not subject to copyright elsewhere and we have permission to use it

Please give as much notice as possible with a minimum of two weeks before the event for the website and one week for Facebook
