Church AGM

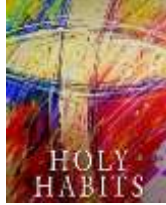
The date for the Church Annual General Meeting is **Sunday 2nd June** at 12:15 following the Church Council Meeting which is to be at 12noon.
